Information about Alexa

Amazon Echo is a "**smart speaker**" product from Amazon that combines voice recognition capabilities with a cylindrical speaker.

Amazon Echo responds to voice control by returning information on products, music, news, weather, sports and more.

The Amazon Echo is always listening for the word "Alexa". This is known as the 'wake word'. Whenever you say it, the Echo will listen to consider what you are saying before giving a response.

The Echo is only listening and storing up to 2 seconds of background noise prior to the wake word being said. No recording of your voice takes place, and until the wake word is said nothing is sent to the internet to be processed.

If you don't want the Echo to wake and respond, there's a mute button on top of the speaker that you can press at any time. Simply press the mute button again when you want the Echo to respond to your voice.

If someone in your family has the name Alex or Alexa then it may be advisable to change the Echo wake word.

The Echo wake word can be changed to "Computer", "Amazon" or "Echo".

This can be changed during your setup and configuration meeting.

Enjoy using your Echo device - please experiment with various commands - and don't worry, you cannot break it!
